



## Spring 2010 REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

---

Students **must meet with their advisor in order to secure their SPRING Registration PIN number which is required to access registration in myPurdue.** Fall appointments will be handled by classification groups. Each classification group will then be given a TIME-TICKET of only 2 – 4 days in which to enter their schedule into *myPurdue*. Student who miss meeting with their advisor PRIOR to their TIME-TICKET date will not be able to enter their schedule until OPEN REGISTRATION in early December '09. Please follow these guidelines and dates very closely:

### STEP #1 ~ Required Progress Meeting with Advisor

Beginning Mon., Sept. 28 students may begin making their appointments.

**Sally Harmon** ~ Come to MTHW 315, in person, (See Tina) to schedule your appt.

**Bobbe Molter** ~ Come to MTHW 223, in person, (See Carmine) to schedule your appt.

**Margie Story** ~ Come to MTHW 223, in person, (See Carmine) to schedule your appt.

#### NOTES:

- Appointments must be made in person.
- All students **MUST** meet with their advisor in order to obtain their PIN number to register for spring '10 in *myPurdue*.

**Spring 2010 Course Notes & Updates**

- The following classes are only offered in the SPRING semester: CSR 21500 & 215L00 (APPAREL & RETAIL), 22100, 22300, 25500 (APPAREL), 30900 (ALL MAJORS), 32700 (APPAREL), and CSR 481 & 48400 (FINANCE).
- If CSR 323 is not offered in Spring '10, Retail Management students may substitute another aesthetics course of their choice from A&D, THTR, MUS, or BAND.
- Students who are going on the Winter Break trip/course to Dubai & Oman (Dec. 28 – Jan. 11) will register for SA 10201 on their SPRING schedule. An override in the

myPurdue system will be required. Finalizing the registration steps will be done during each student's one-on-one advising session with a CSR academic advisor.

- Students who plan to Study Abroad for Spring or Summer 2010 need to check out the **CFS Study Abroad website**, and the **Purdue Study Abroad** website. Students who plan or have been accepted in to the Study Abroad Program for Spring 2010 need to obtain the courses available for the semester. The possible courses can be found on the specific school website (through the study abroad website for the program). Students must have an academic advising appointment to complete the course equivalency paperwork. For the meeting, the student should bring the Study Abroad form from Young 105 (or the web) and available courses offered at the Study Abroad location. **Be sure to schedule for at LEAST 40 minutes.**
