

SCHOLASTIC DEFICIENCY

A. Scholastic Probation

A candidate for an associate or baccalaureate degree shall be placed on probation if his/her semester or graduation GPA at the end of any semester is **less than** that required for a student with his/her classification as shown in Table A.

A student on probation shall be removed from that status at the end of the first subsequent semester in which he/she achieves semester and total GPA **equal to or greater** than those required for a student with his/her classification as shown in Table A.

Any grade change due to a reporting error will require reconsideration of probation status.

Table A. Index Levels for Probation

B. Dropping of Students for Scholastic Deficiency

A student on scholastic probation shall be dropped from the University if, at the close of any semester, his/her total GPA is **less than** that required of a student as shown in Table B **or** if he/she receives **failing (F, WF) grades in six credit hours** or more for the semester.
