## Hospitality and Tourism Management (HTM)

### **CODO Requirements and Process:**

Prospective CODO Students must attend an HTM CODO Information Meeting.  
Selection is based on an application process.

*The application deadline is the tenth week of the semester.*

*The selection process is competitive. Resource limitations shall determine the number of students in each classification that may be permitted to enroll as prospective CODO students. Therefore it is imperative that each student have an alternate plan in case they are not selected.*

*Application includes the application form, a résumé, and a Recommendation Form.*

In order to apply, students must meet the following requirements:

Attend an HTM CODO Information Meeting.

Complete at least 12 credit hours at Purdue University.

*The acceptance of the student's application whose classification is 01 or who is a new transfer student to the university will be conditional until his/her first semester grades at Purdue University are recorded.*

Minimum GPA is 2.0.

Note: Applications will not be accepted from students who are on Academic Probation.

Students who are selected will be given permission to enroll in HTM 17300, 18100, and 19100.

### **Courses available to students who are interested in Hospitality and Tourism Management:**

**It is imperative that you understand that taking these courses does not mean your major is HTM. You will only be able to apply these courses to an HTM degree, IF you are accepted as a CODO student for HTM.**

Competency Requirements: Aesthetic Selective (3 cr.); Foreign Language (6 cr. – 20100 and 20200); Culture & Diversity Selective (3 cr.); MA 15200 or MA 15300; STAT 11300 or STAT 30100; Natural Science Selective (3 cr.); COM 11400; COM Selective; ENGL 10600 or ENGL 10800; POL Selective; PSY 12000; SOC 10000; PHIL Selective; CS 11000 or CNIT 13600

Major Requirements: HTM 10010 (This course is only taught in the Fall semester.)

As stated above, if you are selected as an HTM CODO applicant, you will be given permission to enroll in HTM 17300, 18100, and 19100

**Enrollment in all other HTM Courses is restricted to students who are officially designated as HTM students on the West Lafayette campus. (NAME RAISES/OVERRIDES ARE NOT AVAILABLE FOR HTM CLASSES.)**

Electives: Approximately 15-16 hours

During your HTM CODO Information Meeting, you will be encouraged to be realistic about your graduation date. **IF you are selected, it will take at least four to five semesters for you to finish your degree**, depending upon your classification. **This is not negotiable! We strongly encourage you to give careful thought as you consider making this commitment.**
