## Retail Management (REMG)

### CODO Requirements:

<b>Program: CSR-BS</b>	<b>Major: Retail Management (REMG)</b>		
<b>Requirements:</b>	<b>Minimum Semesters: 1</b>	<b>Minimum Hours: 12</b>	<b>Minimum GPA: 2.5</b>
<b>Course Requirements:</b>	<b>CSR 20900 with a grade of B or better, CSR 34200 with a grade of C or better.</b> See comments for additional information.		
<b>Comments:</b>	Students who earn at least a C in CSR 20900 and whose overall GPA is 2.0 or better will be placed in a pool and accepted on a space available basis, according to their academic credentials. However, students who have not successfully completed CSR 34200 will not be considered. No student on Academic Probation may CODO into Retail Management.		

Students interested in CODOing into REMG must meet with a CFS Advisor to discuss their academic credentials, the CODO requirements and the CODO process.

### Sequencing of Retail Management Courses

**Note:** Students interested in REMG should plan on at least 2-3 semesters to complete the REMG major course sequence after they have CODOed into Retail Management. Below is the typical plan that students will be expected to follow after CODOing into Retail Management. This plan is dependent upon the availability of space and the sequencing of courses.
